# Salute to Service: Sustainability and National Security

12th Air Force Commander, Davis Monthan Air Force Base

As Commander, General Seip oversaw Air Force assets, five forward-operating locations, and civil and military engagements in Central/South America and the Caribbean. Seip had a direct impact in supporting combat operations in Iraqi Freedom and Enduring Freedom and Joint Task Force-Horn of Africa. He currently serves on the Executive Advisory Council of Mission Readiness: Military Leaders for Kids, a bipartisan organization of 140 retired senior military leaders.

General Seip will discuss sustainability initiatives at the Department of Defense, the world's largest institutional consumer of fossil fuels. From Afghanistan to Fort Huachuca, the DoD is aggressively shrinking its carbon footprint and moving toward biofuels, solar, and other renewable energies.
