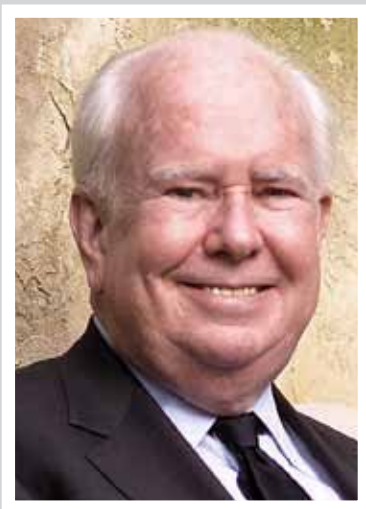


The Future of Biodiversity: What can we do about it?
